A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Rev. R. D. Brown Place, Borough of Brooklyn.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Rev. R. D. Brown Place	St. Mark's Avenue	between Eastern Parkway and East New York Avenue

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
