A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a bikeway/walkway name, Jerry Driscoll Walk, Borough of Manhattan.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following bikeway/walkway name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Jerry Driscoll Walk	East River Bikeway/Walkway	the Peck Slip portion of the East River Bikeway/Walkway

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
