**A LOCAL LAW**

**In relation to an interchange, Police Officer Charles Oddo Interchange, Borough of Brooklyn.**

*Be it enacted by the Council as follows:*

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Police Officer Charles Oddo Interchange	65th Street – 67th Street Interchange	entire 65th Street – 67th Street Interchange on the Belt Parkway

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
