**A LOCAL LAW**

**In relation to a street name, John Cardinal O'Connor Way, Borough of Manhattan.**

*Be it enacted by the Council as follows:*

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
John Cardinal O'Connor Way	50 <sup>th</sup> Street	between 5 <sup>th</sup> Avenue and Madison Avenue

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
