A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Dyker Heights Boulevard, Borough of Brooklyn.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

<u>New name</u>	<u>Present name</u>	<u>Limits</u>
Dyker Heights Boulevard	13 th Avenue	from 86 th Street to Bay Ridge Avenue

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
