A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Guild For Exceptional Children Way, Borough of Brooklyn.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

Guild for Exceptional Children Way	68 th Street	between Ridge Boulevard and 3 rd Avenue

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
