A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a corner name, **Bernard H. Mendik Corner, Borough of Manhattan.**

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following corner name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

Bernard H. Mendik Corner	None	the southwest corner of Lexington Avenue and East 51 st Street

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
