A LOCAL LAW

To amend the New York City charter in relation to including provisional employees in the quarterly city agency reports on total employment.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph 13 of subdivision a of section 814 of the of the New York City charter is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 814. a. (13) To establish a uniform format to be utilized by all city agencies in the preparation of the quarterly reports required by subdivision i of section eight hundred fifteen. Such format shall provide for the presentation of statistical information regarding total employment, including provisional, seasonal, per-diem and part-time employees, new hiring and promotions in a manner which facilitates understanding of an agency's efforts to provide fair and effective equal opportunity employment for minority group members, women and members of other groups who are employed by, or who seek employment, with city agencies;

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
