## LOCAL LAWS OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK FOR THE YEAR 2015

No. 75

Introduced by Council Members Rodriguez, Lancman, Koslowitz, King, Constantinides, Chin, Levin, Dromm, Rosenthal and Kallos.

## A LOCAL LAW

In relation to requiring a study on the impact of growth in the taxicab and for-hire vehicle industries.

*Be it enacted by the Council as follows:* 

Section 1. The taxicab and limousine commission, in collaboration with other relevant city agencies including, but not limited to, the department of transportation and the department of environmental protection, shall complete a study regarding the impact of growth in the taxicab, street hail livery, for-hire vehicle, black car, and luxury limousine industries on traffic, air quality, noise, and public health. Such study shall consider, at a minimum, the following factors: i) the number of driver's licenses issued and renewed within the previous three years; ii) the number of driver's licenses eligible for renewal that were not renewed within the previous three years; iii) the number of vehicle licenses issued and renewed within the previous three years; iv) the number of base station licenses, black car base licenses, and luxury limousine base licenses issued and renewed within the previous three years; vi) the number of base station licenses, black car base licenses, and luxury limousine base licenses eligible for renewal that that were not renewed within the previous three years; and vii) usage of taxicab, street hail livery, for-hire vehicle, black car, and luxury limousine service in each borough within the previous three years, to the extent such

information is available. No later than April 30, 2016, such study shall be submitted to the speaker of the council and posted on the commission's official website.

§ 2. This local law takes effect immediately.
