Introduced by Council Members Williams, Dickens, Gentile, Vallone, Kallos and Levin (by request of the Mayor).

A LOCAL LAW

To amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to tax exemption and abatement for certain rehabilitated buildings as authorized by section 488-a of the real property tax law.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (i) of subdivision b of section 11-244 of the administrative

code of the city of New York, as amended by local law number 56 for the year 2007, is amended to

read as follows:

(i) the eligible improvements are commenced after July first, nineteen hundred

eighty, and prior to December thirty-first, two thousand [eleven] *nineteen*, and are completed within thirty-six months from commencement;

§ 2. This local law takes effect immediately.
